

We have written to the Board of Directors on behalf of 13 residents of Alamo Country Club who need assistance during emergency evacuations. Previously, the City of Alamo assisted the residents with their request, but we were told this service is no longer available. Furthermore, the critical needs residents would have to self-register.

The Hidalgo County Emergency Preparedness Coordinator Ricardo Saldana stated that the city is required to register the residents and assist during emergencies.
